WHAT IS GARBAGE ENZYME?

Using and making your own Garbage Enzyme is a growing trend among those who know about it and care about the earth.

Garbage Enzyme is an organic solution produced by the simple fermentation of fresh vegetable waste, brown sugar and water, in much the same process that wine is made. This fermentation creates a vinegar-like liquid with natural proteins, mineral salts and enzymes that make it magnificently multipurpose in and out of the home.

Garbage Enzyme is a non-toxic, anti-bacterial cleanser, air purifier, deodoriser, insecticide, organic fertiliser, drain cleaner, car cleaner and more. It has uses in home and office, and even outdoors in gardens and farming.

The Garbage Enzyme revolution was started by Dr Rosukon from Thailand.

She has been in enzyme research for more than 30 years and encourages people to make garbage enzyme at home to ease global warming.
